

## SECTION 07563 - ROOF CUTTING AND PATCHING

## PART 1 - GENERAL

## 1.01 DESCRIPTION:

- A. Work under this section is subject to requirements of the Contract Documents including the General Conditions and Supplementary Conditions and applicable portions of Division 1 - General Requirements.
- B. The work consists of all labor, materials and equipment necessary and required to complete all cutting and patching of existing roof system as shown on the drawings and specified herein.

## 1.02 RELATED WORK SPECIFIED ELSEWHERE:

- A. H.V.A.C. Equipment: Division 15.
- B. Roof Specialties and Accessories: Section 07700.
- C. Reroofing: Section 07505.
- D. Flashing and Sheet Metal: Section 07600.

## 1.03 QUALITY ASSURANCE:

- A. Conform with the requirements of NRCA, except where more stringent requirements are shown or specified.

## 1.04 JOB CONDITIONS:

- A. Weather: Proceed with roof cutting and patching work only when existing and forecasted weather conditions will permit work to be performed in accordance with warranty requirements.

## PART 2 - PRODUCTS

## 2.01 GENERAL:

- A. Compatibility: Provide products which are recommended by manufacturers to be fully compatible with indicated substrates, or provide separation materials as required to eliminate contact between incompatible materials.

## 2.02 MATERIALS:

- A. Roofing, flashing, and all other materials necessary and required for patching of openings in existing roof shall be same as existing materials, unless otherwise acceptable to Architect.

## 2.03 SUBCONTRACTOR:

- A. The subcontractor for performing all cutting and patching of existing roof shall be acceptable to Owner and Architect.

## PART 3 - EXECUTION

## 3.01 INSPECTION:

- A. Sub-contractor shall examine substrate and conditions under which roof cutting and patching work is to be performed and notify General Contractor in writing of unsatisfactory conditions. Do not proceed with work until unsatisfactory conditions have been corrected.

3.02 PERFORMANCE:

- A. Execute roof cutting and patching by methods which will prevent damage to other work and will provide proper surfaces to receive installation of new work.
